The disciplines of reading your Bible, studying your Bible, and abiding in Christ lead us to the discipline of prayer. How do we pray like Jesus?

1.	Jesus' Disciplined(6-7)
	o "out of the world" – "ekklesia" = called out
	o "everything comes from you" – be careful of false teaching
2.	Jesus' Disciplined(9)
	o "I pray for them" – John uses the word "to make request" when writing of intercessory prayer
	o John 4:31
	o Prayer should bring us face to face and into close contact with God. Prayer is more than a
	mechanical act or a formula to follow; it is a vehicle to bring us to a place whereby we may enjoy a
	close, intimate relationship with God.
3.	Jesus' Disciplined(10-11)
	o some clear things to pray:
	• "glory of God to come to them" – applies to personal needs and to unbelievers
	• "protect them by the power of your name" – praying "in Jesus' name" is something He wil
	authorize
	• "so they may be one" – the enemy places people in every congregation to work for him,
	seeking to divide
