## 1. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Missions (11-12)

- Extraordinary – going beyond what is usual, regular, or customary
- Miracles – *dunamis* – miraculous power; “dynamite”
- We must focus on the \_\_\_\_\_, not the \_\_\_\_\_.
- The power of missions is the \_\_\_\_\_ working within the life of a believer.

## 2. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Missions (13-14)

- This is a great example of how badly things can go when we try to do things in our own power.
- Having a healthy respect for the power of our adversary is not the same as being afraid to fight our battles in the power of the Holy Spirit.
- The problem of missions comes when we refuse to \_\_\_\_\_ what the \_\_\_\_\_ commands or we try to obey in our own strength.

## 3. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Missions (15-16)

- Know – *ginōskō* – to know by \_\_\_\_\_
- Recognize – *ēpistamai* – to know by \_\_\_\_\_

- We aren't here to make ourselves known; we are here to make Jesus known.
