

**1. What do you \_\_\_\_\_? (19-21)**

- “\_\_\_\_\_” – *thēsaurozō* – to amass or reserve.
- A more precise rendering in the Greek would be “\_\_\_\_\_.”
  - Proverbs 23:4-5
  - Hebrews 13:5
  - Matthew 19:16-22
  - 1 Timothy 6:17-19
  - 1 Timothy 6:6
- “\_\_\_\_\_” – *kardia* – the heart, figuratively the thoughts or feelings.
  - “Your heart will follow your treasure.” – Tony Evans

**2. What is your \_\_\_\_\_? (22-23)**

- “\_\_\_\_\_” – *luchnōs* – an illuminator.
  - Psalm 119:105
  - “\_\_\_\_\_” – *haplōus* – single (figuratively clear).

**3. Who is your \_\_\_\_\_? (24)**

- “\_\_\_\_\_” – *kuriōs* – supreme in authority, *i.e.*, controller.
- “\_\_\_\_\_” – *dōelēuō* – to be a slave to.
- “\_\_\_\_\_” – worldly wealth.
