

**1. Which Tree Are You? (16-20)**

- There are only two possible answers to this question: a good tree or a bad tree.
  - \_\_\_\_\_ - *agathōs* – beneficial.
  - \_\_\_\_\_ - *saprōs* – rotten, worthless, corrupt.
    - We produce good fruit to help others know Christ so they can produce good fruit to help others know Christ, and so on and so on.
  - Sadly, bad fruit has the same effect in the \_\_\_\_\_ direction.
    - Matthew 12:33; James 1:14-15; Galatians 6:7-8; Numbers 32:23.
  - There is no way to stay \_\_\_\_\_ when it comes to what kind of tree you are.
    - Matthew 3:10; John 15:1-2.

**2. Where Will You End Up? (21-23)**

- (21) Jesus goes into further detail about the difference between a \_\_\_\_\_ (fake Christian) and a \_\_\_\_\_ (His follower).
  - The verbal confession of Jesus is important, but that alone will not save you.
- (22) There are three things the phonies claim to have done in Jesus' name that they try to use as justification for getting into heaven:
  - \_\_\_\_\_ - to speak under inspiration, exercise the prophetic office.
    - 1 Corinthians 13:2
  - \_\_\_\_\_
    - Mark 3:13-15; Mark 9:25-29
  - \_\_\_\_\_ - mighty (wonderful) work.
    - These are people with an \_\_\_\_\_ appearance but a \_\_\_\_\_ heart.
- (23) If we don't know \_\_\_\_\_, we will not enter \_\_\_\_\_.
  - 1 John 2:15-17
  - Jesus used three stories in Matthew 25 to describe the way to get to heaven. *See* verses 12, 30, and 41.
  - "I never knew you" also reminds us that nobody can lose their salvation.
