

1. Jesus is not \_\_\_\_\_:
  - “divided or dividing into two sharply distinguished parts or classifications”
    - He is every one of the names that are used in the Bible to describe Him all at once and He cannot be separated from Himself.
  
2. Jesus is not \_\_\_\_\_:
  - Jesus left no doubt who He believed himself to be during His time on earth.
    - John 14:6-7
  - Jesus wasn’t delusional about who He was, and neither were those closest to Him during His earthly ministry.
    - John 1:29
    - Matthew 16:16
  - There are four references to Him as “Lord and Savior,” all found in 2 Peter:
    - 2 Peter 1:11
    - 2 Peter 2:20
    - 2 Peter 3:1-2
    - 2 Peter 3:17-18
  
3. Jesus is not \_\_\_\_\_:
  - Three times “Savior” comes before “Lord” but never in the same manner as “Lord and Savior”:
    - Luke 2:11
    - Philippians 3:20
    - Jude 1:24-25
  - For Jesus to save someone who didn’t call on Him as their Lord would make Him a dysfunctional \_\_\_\_\_ and a dishonest \_\_\_\_\_.
  
4. Jesus is \_\_\_\_\_:
  - Only when you really \_\_\_\_\_ Christ can you truly \_\_\_\_\_ Christ.
  - Anyone can say the words “Jesus is Lord,” but only someone with intimate knowledge of what the phrase means can really mean it because they are filled with the Holy Spirit!
    - 1 Corinthians 12:3
    - Matthew 7:21
    - “Lord” – *kuriōs* – supreme in authority; master.
