

## God's Treasured Possession

Malachi 3:16-18

1. God Promised \_\_\_\_\_ (16)
  - When those who understand and appreciate their position as \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_ talk positively about Him and to Him, it matters because:
    - It is a great way to open doors to \_\_\_\_\_ the gospel. John 13:35.
    - It moves the \_\_\_\_\_ of God. James 5:16.
  
2. God Promised \_\_\_\_\_ (17a)
  - He calls them His “\_\_\_\_\_,” which is also translated “jewels” or “treasured possession.”
    - No matter what your perception is, never forget God keeps His \_\_\_\_\_ and will also keep His \_\_\_\_\_. Isaiah 55:9.
  
3. God Promised \_\_\_\_\_ (17b)
  - Here is another comparison to the relationship between God and His people to that of a \_\_\_\_\_ with his \_\_\_\_\_. Psalm 103:13-14, Lamentations 3:31-32.
    - Our obedience and service are \_\_\_\_\_, not \_\_\_\_\_, of our relationship with God as His children.
  
4. God Promised \_\_\_\_\_ (18)
  - He closes this chapter with a reminder that it will be easy to differentiate between those who love and serve God (“\_\_\_\_\_”) and those who don't (“\_\_\_\_\_”).
    - In other words, only those who “\_\_\_\_\_ the \_\_\_\_\_” and have a “high regard for his name” will be in the Book of Life. Psalm 56:8, Daniel 12:1.
