



## Staying Connected to Christ 1 John 2:3-6

According to this passage, there are two ways to know we have **come to** Christ:

1. Knowing by \_\_\_\_\_ His \_\_\_\_\_ (3)
  - This means the \_\_\_\_\_ of the law as well as the \_\_\_\_\_ of the law.
  
2. Knowing by \_\_\_\_\_ His \_\_\_\_\_ (5a)
  - “\_\_\_\_\_” – *tēlēiōō* – to complete, to accomplish, or to consummate, to perfect. This is the same root as the Greek word “*tetelestai*” – “it is finished” – spoken by Jesus in John 19:30 as He died on the cross.
    - The work of making us complete is a \_\_\_\_\_ already done by Christ’s \_\_\_\_\_ on the cross.

There are also two ways to know we are **connected to** Christ:

1. Knowing by \_\_\_\_\_ (6a)
  - If we remain in Christ, we will be \_\_\_\_\_.
    - Matthew 7:20.
  
2. Knowing by \_\_\_\_\_ (6b)
  - This passage literally says we know we are His because we \_\_\_\_\_ like He \_\_\_\_\_. That means we are called to a \_\_\_\_\_ life.
    - Matthew 20:28.
