## Three Things Moms Do Proverbs 1:8-9, 1 Thess. 2:7, 2 Timothy 1:5

- 1. Moms \_\_\_\_\_ Proverbs 1:8-9
  - instruction *"mûwcâr"* " chastisement, correction, discipline.
  - o listen "shâma" to hear \_\_\_\_\_.
    - It is to hear \_\_\_\_\_\_ to act, but leaves room for \_\_\_\_\_\_ of what is heard.
  - God won't give you a pass for living in sin just because your lost parents tell you to.
  - God won't give you a pass for ignoring godly advice given by godly parents.
- 2. Moms \_\_\_\_\_ 1 Thessalonians 2:7
  - "Although we could have been a burden as Christ's apostles, instead we were gentle among you, as a nurse {nursing mother} nurtures her own children."
