

## **The Foolish and the Wise, Pt. 2**

1 Corinthians 2:1-11

### 1. Paul's Work (1-5)

- Paul was given an \_\_\_\_\_ in Acts 9:15-16.
  - He didn't preach with \_\_\_\_\_ or ignorance; he preached with a \_\_\_\_\_.
- If Paul shared the gospel in \_\_\_\_\_, then why would we not follow his example?

### 2. God's Wisdom (6-9)

- Paul said his preaching was so that their faith would be based on God's \_\_\_\_\_, which is based on God's wisdom.

### 3. The Spirit's Revelation (10-11)

3. the Spirit revealed God's will to Paul just like He will reveal it to us.
